- Meet the demand for skills and knowledge in circular furniture design.



Results:

- The consortium will elaborate a curriculum for Circular Furniture Designers, focusing on the principles of circular economy and sustainable design.
- Online training course for Circular Furniture Designers: an e-learning platform that offers an open online training course for Circular Furniture Designers.
- The consortium will conduct a pilot course, a hackathon, and a physical mobility program to validate the results and provide hands-on learning experiences for participants.
- Dissemination activities including a website with public results, a video, one leaflet, a LinkedIn group, workshops, and a final event.
